13 14		effects of the spill in response to demands by the Nation, has
15		implemented changes in the methods used to transport raffinate so

18		equipped with a moisture detection device to warn of possible future
19		
20		spills, and has improved its environmental preparedness through
21		training of its employees and management and the creation of an
22		environmental response plane and
