**RESOLUTION NO. 96-080**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is fully authorized to act on behalf of**  
**our members in matters arising under the Indian Self-Determination**  
**Act of 1975, P.L. 93-638, as amended, 25 U.S.C. 450 et. seq.,**  
**(hereafter the Act); and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council is empowered to act**  
**for and on behalf of its Tohono O'odham Members in adopting**  
**resolutions; and**

**WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service (IHS) has instituted a grant program for**  
**Indian Tribes to improve the management capacity of a tribal**  
**organization to enter into contracts with IHS under the Indian Self-**  
**Determination Act; and**

**WHEREAS, either the Sells Service Unit or Tucson Area Office provides services**  
**through the Sells Service Unit Hospital, Santa Rosa Health Clinic, and**  
**San Xavier Health Center predominantly to the membership of the**  
**Tohono O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service (IHS) recognizes that the Tohono O'odham**  
**Nation can assume operations and management of either the Sells**

Service Unit Hospital, or the Santa Rosa Health Clinic, or the San Xavier Health Center, or all, under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended; and

**WHEREAS,** these grant funds will provide financial support to conduct a feasibility study to ascertain whether or not it is feasible for the Tohono O'odham Nation to assume operations and management of either the Sells Service Unit Hospital, or the Santa Rosa Health Clinic, or the San Xavier Health Center, or all, under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended; and

**WHEREAS,** this resolution shall remain in effect until such time as this resolution has been fully completed, expressly rescinded or modified by the Legislative Council.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports the Chairman, or his designee to submit a grant application of \$55,612 to conduct a feasibility study to ascertain whether or not it is feasible for the Tohono O'odham Nation to assume operations and management of either the Sells Service Unit

Hospital, or the Santa Rosa Health Clinic, or the San Xavier Health Center, or all, under the authority of the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chairman, or his designate, is hereby authorized to sign and/or negotiate any terms, or conditions, or modifications to this tribal management grant with the Indian Health Service.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 4TH day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section I(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
