NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program from the State of Arizona, Department of Health Services.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the 9 Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the 10 interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed 11 12 contract has been awarded by the State of Arizona. 13 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the 14 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any 15 16 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute 17 the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the 18 19 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for 20 further prior approval by this Council. 21 22 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7TH. 23 day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the 25 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 26 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 27 (48 Stat. 984). 28
