

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving FY 1997 Tuberculosis Control Program Proposal)**

RESOLUTION NO. 96-090

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Tuberculosis Control Program to help prevent the spread of the disease through community education, prevention, early detection, comprehensive regimens and careful follow up with individuals; and

WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program has been provided in part through supplemental funding sources; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program desires to continue the services it provides to TB susceptible patients; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program has received funding from the State of Arizona, Department of Health Services for its program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it hereby approves the proposal for funding of the Tohono O'odham Tuberculosis Control Program from the State of Arizona, Department of Health Services.

10 Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the
11 interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed
12 contract has been awarded by the State of Arizona.

14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

16 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any
17 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
18 the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
19 funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for
20
21 further prior approval by this Council.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7TH
24 day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
25 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the
26 powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the
27 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
28 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984).
