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4 **WHEREAS, Low Income Home Energy Assistance funds have been made**

6 **available to the Tohono O'odham Nation for FY 1997 through the**  
7 **State of Arizona, Department of Economic Security; and**

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9 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does meet the eligibility requirement**  
10 **to operate a Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program; and**

12 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'odham Nation to apply for**  
13 **FY 1997 Low Income Home Energy Assistance funds to assist needy**  
14 **families with their residential utility bills; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to secure funding for**  
18 **provision of services during Fiscal Year 1997.**

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20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
21 **Council does hereby approve the proposal to the State of Arizona,**  
22 **Department of Economic Security for FY 1997 Low Income Home**  
23 **Energy Assistance funding.**

26 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the contract is July 01, 1996**  
27 **through June 30, 1997.**




