4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has successfully operated a program for  
5  
6 the elderly members of the Nation; and

7 **WHEREAS,** funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has been made  
8  
9 possible in part by Title III of the Older American's Act of 1965 as  
10 amended, through the Administration of the Inter-Tribal Council of  
11  
12 Arizona; and

13 **WHEREAS,** the services provided to elderly members has been beneficial and  
14  
15 services continue to be necessary to provide nutritional and social  
16  
17 support; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Elderly Program has prepared a proposal for FY 1997 Title III  
19  
20 funding to provide nutritional and social support services to eligible  
21  
22 elderly members.

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
24  
25 that it hereby approves the proposal for Title III funding for the  
26  
27 Elderly Program to continue to provide such services it has proposed  
28  
in light of the requirements and regulations.



6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

8 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any  
9  
10 designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute  
11  
12 the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the  
13  
14 funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further  
15  
16 prior approval by this Council.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7TH  
18 day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote  
19 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the  
20 powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the  
21 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,  
22 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs  
23 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934  
24 (48 Stat. 984).
