

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Appropriations Request for the Water Resources Study Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 96-101

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council establishes priorities annually for consideration by Congress; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is aware of the Water Resources Department's need to seek additional funding for the Water Resources Inventory Study; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council was informed that in order to complete a comprehensive water inventory, in accordance with Section 303(b) of the Southern Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act, adequate funding should be provided; and

WHEREAS, a funding level of \$5,747,000 for a four (4) year study has been determined by the Nation's Water Resources Department; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council supports the completion of the water inventory study as the data collected would be of beneficial importance to the current and future generations of the Tohono O'odham in the management of their natural resources.

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3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
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5 Council hereby approves the appropriation request of the Nation's
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7 Water Resources Department.

8 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Congress appropriate \$5,747,000 in FY 1997 to
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10 adequately fund for four (4) years for the period 1997 to FY 2000.

11 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that Congress has executed P.L. 97-293 (SAWRSA),
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13 but has not made adequate funding available to carry out its
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15 obligation.

16 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby
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18 authorizes the Tohono O'odham Appropriations Committee to present
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20 this request to the appropriate members and committees of
21
22 Congress.

24 day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
25 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the
26 powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section 1(j) of the Constitution of the
27 Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,
28 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984).
