**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has conducted a comprehensive review  
process of the proposed P.L. 93-638 regulations; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has considered the  
Comments and Proposed Language produced as a result of this  
community review process; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council finds that the Comments  
and Proposed Language are a true and correct reflection of the  
general thinking of the O'odham community with regards to P.L. 93-  
638 contracting; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has considered the issue of  
a congressional extension for the period to issue implementing P.L.  
93-638 regulations and is opposed to any such extension.


