

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Request for Solicitation to the appropriate Congressional Committees for
funding for the Tohono O'odham Judiciary P.O.N.I. Project)

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RESOLUTION NO. 96-110

WHEREAS, P.L. 99II-570, the Omnibus Drug Enforcement, Education and Control Act, Title IV, Subtitle C, cited as the Indian Alcohol and Substance Abuse Prevention and Treatment Act of 1986, authorized the construction or renovation of new or existing Juvenile Detention and Rehabilitation Centers for purposes of the Act; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council by Resolution Nos. 71-88, 342-88, 08-89, 94-403 and 94-538 approved and supported the Judicial Branch in identifying and implementing community based, rehabilitative programs of treatment and therapy for O'odham Youth; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has complied and met the requirements for submission of the draft submittal, as required by the contract deadline and the planning phase has now been complete; and

WHEREAS, the design phase has been placed on hold status, due to lack of funding and is currently ranked at number 13, according to the

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Federal Register dated December 30, 1993; and

**WHEREAS, the Judiciary Branch requests the Legislative Council and the
Chairman's Office to actively inquire and solicit to the appropriate
congressional committees, the current status and time frames for
complete funding for construction and operation of the Tohono
O'odham Juvenile Detention Center (P.O.N.I).**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council:

- 1) That the Council actively inquire and solicit to the appropriate
congressional committees, the current status and time frames
for complete funding for construction and operation of the
Tohono O'odham Juvenile Detention Center (P.O.N.I).**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7TH
day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
1,524.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 150.0 NOT VOTING; and 247.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant
to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI Section I(j) of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
