4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has through Resolution Nos.

6 18-83 and 95-066 reaffirmed an interest in acquiring the Eastern
7 portion of Baboquivari Peak as a part of the Tohono O'odham
8 Nation; and

10 **WHEREAS,** the Baboquivari Peak is crucial and considered sacred to the
11
12 O'odham of this Nation; and

13 **WHEREAS,** acquiring the said Peak will be made whole, thereby preserving its
14
15 significance to the O'odham.

16 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council

18 that it hereby supports and approves acquiring the eastern portion
19
20 of Baboquivari Peak and requesting the Arizona Congressional
21 delegation to support the Tohono O'odham Nation's requests for a
22
23 memorial in acquiring the eastern portion of the Baboquivari Peak.

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Nation claim all the lands

26 constituting the Baboquivari Peak and mountain as the central

28 sacred and culture site of the O'odham and respectfully requests the

transfer of the lands constituting the eastern slope to the Tohono

Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to

Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
