RESOLUTION NO. 96-119

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation with a land base of 2.8 million acres
and a population of 19,000 members contracts its own Law
Enforcement Program under P.L. 93-638; and**

**WHEREAS, since the increase in the number of Police Officers to the Tohono
O'odham Police Department there is a need to increase support
staff; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Police Department has identified specific areas
of proposed increased support staffing and related operating
expenses; and**

**WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the
Tohono O'odham Police Department in their request to increase the
funding under P.L. 93-638 to provide for increased support staff and
related operating expenses.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation requests
appropriation for an increase in funding for the Tohono O'odham
Police Department in the amount of \$885,853.**

Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
