**Native American Tribes/Nations and higher education institutions**  
**in addressing retention issues related to the academic success of**  
**Native American College students; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will benefit from this conference**  
**which is co-sponsored by the University of Arizona, Arizona State**  
**University and Northern Arizona.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
**Council that it hereby supports and allocates \$3,000.00 to the 1996**  
**Retention in Education for Today's American Indian Nations**  
**(R.E.T.A.I.N.) from the general fund account.**



The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 28TH. day of MARCH, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,637.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 239.0 (11) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
