**4** **WHEREAS,** the Native American Fair Employment Rights Committee (NAFERC)

**6** is an urban Indian organization created in January 1995; and

**7** **WHEREAS,** NAFERC's purpose is to act as advocate and to consolidate support

**9** for Native American Indians, reservation and urban, from all walks  
**10** of life, who seek white collar and blue collar, as well as professional  
**11** jobs and other services throughout Pima County; and

**13** **WHEREAS,** the NAFERC, working on a volunteer basis, seeks endorsement and

**15** support from the Tohono O'odham Nation and other tribal  
**16** governments in the southern area in their efforts to provide Indian  
**17** people better job opportunities, fair treatment, as well as other  
**18** services; and

**20** **WHEREAS,** the NAFERC was instrumental in establishing the Indian Employment  
**21**  
**22** Policy, passed by the Pima County Board of Supervisors, the first of  
**23** its kind throughout the county.

**25** **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
**26** Council does hereby endorse and support the Native American Fair  
**27** Employment Rights Committee (NAFERC).


