WHEREAS, the National Indian Gaming Association/National Congress of American Indians (NIGA/NCAI) Task Force adopted Resolution OTF#1 on March 31, 1996, (copy attached) calling on the Clinton Administration to support Indian gaming through actions specified in the resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation ("Nation") is a member in good standing of NIGA and a founding member of NCAI; and

WHEREAS, NIGA and NCAI developed the NIGA/NCAI Task Force to address gaming issues affecting all Indian tribes; and

WHEREAS, the Nation and the State of Arizona executed a gaming compact in June 1993 which is an existing, valid and enforceable compact; and

WHEREAS, the Nation is aware of the detrimental effects of the Seminole Tribe v. Florida decision; and

WHEREAS, the Commerce Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council recommends that the Nation support the NIGA/NCAI Resolution OTF#1.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation supports the NIGA/NCAI Task Force Resolution OTF#1, and supports the efforts of tribes to obtain compacts or procedures which recognize their sovereign rights to conduct and regulate gaming under the principles of the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act and Cabazon.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 10TH day of APRIL, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,742.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 134.0 (04) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(c)(2) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


