WHEREAS. the Natural Resources Committee recommends that the Nation go forward with acquiring the cemetery property near Darby Wells from the BLM for the Hia Ced O'odham, that the Nation express its interest in additional properties managed by the BLM, including the surface rights to the Bluebird property, which additional properties are to be identified within 15 days after the effective date of this resolution by the Hia Ced O'odham program of the Nation, and that

any such properties acquired by the Nation be maintained by the

United States in trust for the Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation authorizes and directs the Chairman of the Nation and the Natural Resources Committee to negotiate with the BLM expressing the Nation's interest in acquiring from the BLM the cemetery parcel near Darby Wells and other parcels identified within 15 days by the Hia Ced O'odham program of the Nation, to

be maintained by the United States in trust for the Nation.
