

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(In support of the Tohono O'odham Youth Services/United Way FY'97 Budget)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-143

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4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono
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6 **O'odham Youth Services Program under an agreement with United**
7 **Way of Tucson; and**

8 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham People are interested in the welfare and

10 **development of the young people residing on the Tohono O'odham**
11 **Nation and have established the Tohono O'odham Youth Services**
12 **(TOYS); and**

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14 **WHEREAS,** the main purpose and goals of the TOYS Program is to promote and
15
16 **encourage young Tohono O'odham people in the fields of recreation,**
17 **education, cultural experiences and youth counseling; and**

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19 **WHEREAS,** these activities will be implemented through planning, coordination
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21 **and evaluation of youth oriented programs and projects reservation**
22 **wide; and**

23 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Youth Services and the Tohono O'odham youth
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25 **need the support, encouragement and involvement from the Tohono**
26 **O'odham Nation, District and Communities, in the provision of these**
27 **services to the youth of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and**
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3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Youth Services/Juvenile Delinquency has**
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5 **submitted a proposal for review and approval by the Tohono**
6
7 **O'odham Legislative Council.**

8 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**
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10 **Council does hereby give its full support for the purpose, goals and**
11 **the efforts of the Tohono O'odham Youth Services/Juvenile**
12 **Delinquency and authorizes to enter into an Agreement with United**
13
14 **Way of Tucson.**

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16 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the Agreement will be from July**
17
18 **01, 1996 through June 30, 1997.**

19 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the**
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21 **Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice**
22 **Chairman are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the**
23 **agreement, provided however, that any amendments affecting the**
24 **funding or funding levels of this contract shall be submitted for**
25 **further prior approval by this Council.**
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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 10TH day of APRIL, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,582.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 294.0 [07] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


