

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL**  
**(Approving the FY 1996 Six Month Budget for Establishing a**  
**Natural Resources Department)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-145**

**WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 91-100 the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation (Nation) authorized the creation of the Natural Resources Department of the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, in Resolution No. 94-257 the Legislative Council confirmed the appointment of Peter Ruiz as Director of the Tohono O'odham Natural Resources Department (Department); and**

**WHEREAS, the Department has never been established; and**

**WHEREAS, Peter Ruiz, as Director of the Department did submit a twelve month budget to the Natural Resources and Budget & Finance Committees for review; and**

**WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee has recommended that the budget be reduced to six months as only half of fiscal year 1996 remains; and**

**WHEREAS, the Budget & Finance Committee has also recommended that expenses for portion of the furnishing of the Department's office be deferred until the building for the office is completed, and these expenses are not included in this budget; and**

**WHEREAS, a supplemental budget to purchase office equipment and furniture  
will be submitted to the Legislative Council after the Department's  
office building is completed; and**

**WHEREAS, the Director of the Department has made the recommended changes  
in the attached six-month budget; and**

**WHEREAS, the budget is for establishing the Department which includes hiring  
an Administrative Assistant for the Department, hiring a Livestock  
Manager and Secretary, construction of an office facility, purchasing  
office equipment for the Department and for the Livestock Office,  
and other related expenses.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council has reviewed  
and approved the six month budget and authorizes expenditures in  
accordance with the attached budget.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the funding will be allocated from the General  
Fund Account.**
