RESOLUTION NO. 96-151

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Scholarship Fund program has
presented a change in the scholarship requirement to include Pell
Grant Applications; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Scholarship Fund is responsible for
scholarship funding to tribal members based on the needs of
students; and

WHEREAS, the Pell Grant Application will be able to provide an exact needs
analysis which would assist in the awarding of students.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council does hereby support the amendment to the Tohono O'odham
Nation Scholarship Fund Application requirement process.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
11TH day of APRIL, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
vote 1,215.0 FOR; 340.0 AGAINST; 187.0 NOT VOTING; and 134.0 [06] ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(I) of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


