RESOLUTION NO. 96-174

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is aware of the needs in the areas of fire protection and fire safety for the Tohono O'odham Nation and its members and thereby supports the establishment of a Nationwide Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 96-073 the Legislative Council did approve the Second Quarter budget for the Tohono O'odham Nation Fire Department in the amount of \$534,969 to allow for further development in all areas of fire protection, prevention and safety; and

WHEREAS, as of March 31, 1996 funds in the amount of \$405,201.25 remain unexpended for the department and the Budget & Finance Committee has recommended that the Fire Department be authorized to continue third quarter operations from April 01, 1996 through June 30, 1996 utilizing these unexpended funds; and

of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
