4 **WHEREAS,** by Resolution No. 08-70, the Nation established the Papago Tribal
5 Utility Authority, now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority
6 (TOUA), for purposes of constructing, maintaining, and operating
7 various utility systems within the Nation to be owned wholly by the
8 Nation; and

11 **WHEREAS,** TOUA requests permission for a Combined Utility Right-Of-Way for
12 a new 3 Phase Overhead Powerline and related facilities to furnish
13 electric services and other utility services to the HICKIWAN DISTRICT
14 Casino; and

17 **WHEREAS,** TOUA has respectfully submitted a map or plat thereof showing the
18 location and scope of the Combined Utility Right-Of-Way and
19 delineating the utility facilities to be placed thereon (as described
20 in the maps, legal description and documents attached hereto and
21 incorporated herein by reference) for uses consistent with the
22 authorized purposes of TOUA; and

27 **WHEREAS,** the HICKIWAN DISTRICT has determined that the routing and location

of the Combined Utility Right-Of-Way for the 3 Phase Overhead Powerline and related facilities is not in conflict with any land use plans adopted by the HICKIWAN DISTRICT, and approved by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council and that the Combined Utility Right-Of-Way will be of substantial benefit to the HICKIWAN DISTRICT, the Tohono O'odham Nation and their respective members; and

WHEREAS, the HICKIWAN DISTRICT COUNCIL approved the requested Combined Right-Of-Way by its District Council Resolution No. 96-10; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee has reviewed the request for the Combined Utility Right-Of-Way and recommends its approval.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the Combined Utility Right-Of-Way for the new 3 Phase Overhead Powerline and related facilities for the location (as more fully described in the attached maps and legal description) and construction by TOUA for uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.

10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




