require a selection criteria for identifying those families most in need of housing who will receive home renovation through the 1996 HOME

grant program; and

WHEREAS, the ten (10) Districts participating in the 1996 HOME grant program (of the 11 Districts which comprise the Tohono O'odham Nation) has defined their selection criteria on the basis of families with elderly and/or handicapped members, families who live in seriously overcrowded conditions, families living in structurally unstable homes, homes in urgent need of repair, homes with no amenities (i.e. indoor plumbing, sewage lines), families with very low income not to exceed 90% of the median income for the area (Pima County, Arizona) adjusted or family size; and

WHEREAS, District Councils consulted with their own Housing Committees and reviewed the applicant list of the Tohono O'odham Housing Authority; and
