**RESOLUTION NO. 96-195**

**WHEREAS, Department of Housing and Urban Development guidelines require**  
**adoption of housing quality and construction standards on projects**  
**funded through the Department's HOME and ICDBG programs; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is applying for funds from both**  
**programs to be used in renovating housing within the Tohono**  
**O'odham Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation recognizes the need and desirability for such standards**  
**and building codes to ensure quality housing for all members of the**  
**Nation.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council that all projects**  
**funded in the 1996 cycle of the HUD HOME and ICDBG programs**  
**renovation work on all homes will conform to the Uniform Building**  
**Code as amended and applied in Pima County, Arizona, the Cost-**  
**Effective Energy Conservation and Effectiveness Standards (CEECS)**  
**detailed in 24 CFR part 39, and Housing Quality Standards (HQS)**


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 8TH day of MAY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,734.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
