**RESOLUTION NO. 96-198**

**WHEREAS, by Resolution 95-528, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**  
**approved an Attorney Contract with the law firm of Quigley, Tang**  
**& Whitehill to provide legal representation as co-counsel with the**  
**Attorney General regarding certain of the Nation's water claims**  
**affected by bankruptcy proceedings, and litigation and negotiations**  
**relating to the Central Arizona Project; and**

**WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is in the amount of \$65,000 for fiscal year**  
**1996; and**

**WHEREAS, continued representation regarding these water matters is required**  
**to protect the Nation's interests; and**

**WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of \$30,000 is necessary for the**  
**Attorney Contract to assure uninterrupted services until the end of**  
**this fiscal year; and**

**WHEREAS, the approved budget for the Office of Attorney General for fiscal**  
**year 1996 contains \$60,000 tentatively allocated for an Attorney**  
**Contract with Gover, Stetson, & Williams, \$30,000 of which is**

unobligated and not required for representation by such law firm in  
fiscal year 1996; and

**WHEREAS,** the Attorney General recommends using these unobligated funds to  
increase the Attorney Contract with Quigley, Tang & Whitehill by  
\$30,000, pursuant to the terms of Amendment No. 1 thereto (copy  
attached); and

**WHEREAS,** the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval by  
the Legislative Council of Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract  
with Quigley, Tang & Whitehill on such terms.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves  
Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract with the law firm  
of Quigley, Tang & Whitehill, in the form attached hereto,  
which increases the Contract amount by \$30,000 for the fiscal  
year ending September 30, 1996.
2. Funding for Amendment No. 1 shall be provided under the

execute Amendment No. 1 to the Attorney Contract.

to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 2 (a) of the Constitution  
of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
