Boys Home and Adolescent Girls Home, and;**

**WHEREAS, in projecting costs for the FY 1996 fiscal year, the Welfare Assistance
Grant Funded programs will be in a deficit of \$713,537.00 and in
order to meet the deficit a plan was developed (attached).**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council does hereby approve the proposed action plan for the
remainder of FY 1996 to meet the welfare assistance grant deficit.**


