

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Supporting the Governor's Declaration of Emergency)**

RESOLUTION NO. 96-215

WHEREAS, Arizona Governor Fife Symington has declared a state of emergency to exist on drought conditions in the State of Arizona effective May 3, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is a part of the State of Arizona; and

WHEREAS, the drought conditions are effecting the Tohono O'odham Nation, endangering crops, property, livestock, wildlife and all natural resources on the Tohono O'odham Nation.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby supports Governor Symington's Declaration of Emergency.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Nation will contact all eleven districts of the Nation on the drought conditions to compile the need for assistance.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation will take necessary steps to request for assistance from the Federal Emergency Funding.


3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the

8 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
9 (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934
(48 Stat. 984).


