4 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 08-70, the Nation established the Papago Tribal**
5 **Utility Authority, now known as Tohono O'odham Utility Authority**
6 **(TOUA), for purposes of constructing, maintaining, and operating**
7 **various utility systems within the Nation to be owned wholly by the**
8 **Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, TOUA requests permission for a Right-Of-Way Utility Easement for**
12 **a new Waterline Extension and Well Site to furnish water facilities**
13 **and other related utility services to the Santa Rosa Ranch**
14 **Community, Schuk Toak District; and**

17 **WHEREAS, TOUA has respectfully submitted all documents, including maps or a**
18 **plat thereof showing the location and scope of the Right-Of-Way**
19 **Utility Easement and delineating the utility facilities to be placed**
20 **thereon (as described more fully in the maps, legal description and**
21 **documents attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference) for**
22 **uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA; and**

26 **WHEREAS, the Schuk Toak District Council approved the requested TOUA Right-**

8 **Council does hereby approve the TOUA Right-Of-Way Utility**
9 **Easement for the new Waterline Extension and Well Site and related**
10 **utility facilities for the location (as more fully described in the**
11 **attached maps and legal description) and construction by TOUA for**
12 **uses consistent with the authorized purposes of TOUA.**

18 **1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the**
19 **powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (i) of the Constitution of the**
20 **Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18,**
21 **1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs**
22 **(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934**
(48 Stat. 984).
