

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(H.R. 2406, Title VII of the United States Housing Act of 1996)**

3 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation, with a land base of approximately 2.8**
4 **million acres and a tribal population of 19,000 has a severe shortage**
5 **of adequate housing; and**

6
7 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation consolidated Housing Inventory**
8 **establishes an immediate unmet need of 875 units of replacement,**
9 **877 new housing and 665 in need of rehab; and**

12 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation must continually develop funding**
13 **resources to address the housing needs of its tribal members; and**

15 **WHEREAS, H.R. 2406, the United States Housing Act of 1996, proposes a new**
16 **Housing delivery system contained in Title VII of the Native**
17 **American Housing Assistance and Self Determination Act of 1996; and**

18
19 **WHEREAS, Title VII of H.R. 2406 proposes to meet the housing responsibilities**
20 **in a manner that recognizes the right of tribal self-governance.**

22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council**
23 **that it hereby supports the components of the Native American**
24 **Housing Assistance and Self-Determination Act of 1996 as currently**
25 **contained in Title VII of the United States Housing Act of 1996, H.R.**
26 **2406 with attached comments.**
