**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono
O'odham Department of Human Services, Division of Family
Assistance, Food Distribution Program under an FY 1996 Grant with
the United States Department of Agriculture; and**

**WHEREAS, such Tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation does desire to continue the provision of
these services at the current level during FY 1997; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved
the FY 1997 Food Distribution proposal and budget request for the
Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services, Divisions of Family
Assistance, Food Distribution Program.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that it does authorize and request the United States
Department of Agriculture to renew this grant with the Tohono
O'odham Nation.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this renewal shall commence on
October 01, 1996 through September 30, 1997.**

costs consistent with the United States Department of Agriculture.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any

designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute

the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the

funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further

17

prior approval by this Council.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the

22 27TH. day of JUNE, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a

23 vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to

24 the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution

of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on

25 January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian

26 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June

18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


