RESOLUTION NO. 96-254

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services/Family Assistance and Child Welfare Services has the primary responsibility to provide for the care, treatment and welfare of O'odham families found to be in the need of such care; and

WHEREAS, Title IV-B Subpart 1 and Subpart 2 of the Social Security Act provides funds for development of a Five Year Plan for demonstrating effective prevention approaches for handling increasing family problems under specified terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, a proposal to continue the five year plan has been submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services/Family Assistance and Child Welfare Services for the FY 1996 Family Preservation/Family Support Services Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the application of the Tohono O'odham Social Service to the Department of Health & Human Services/Administration for Children and Families to continue the development of the Five Year Plan.

8 grant has been approved by the Department of Health & Human

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
13 Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice
14 Chairman, and any designated Official are hereby authorized to
15 negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any
16 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall
17 be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
22 27TH. day of JUNE, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
23 vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [07] ABSENT, pursuant to
24 the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution
25 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
26 January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
27 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
28 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


