**WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act was enacted into law in 1982**  
**replacing Comprehensive Employment Training Act (CETA); and**

**WHEREAS, the Job Training Partnership Act (JTPA) funds are made available**  
**to State and Tribal Governments from the United States Department**  
**of Labor to establish employment and training programs for**  
**improving the employment prospects of eligible persons; and**

**WHEREAS, Indian Reservations in Arizona have been designated as service**  
**delivery areas and are eligible to receive Federal JTPA funds; and**

**WHEREAS, the Nation is entitled to JTPA funds to develop a network of**  
**employment training programs throughout the Nation; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated the Title IV-A program**  
**since 1974; and**

**WHEREAS, the JTPA Program have submitted for review and approval the Title**  
**IV-A Grant Proposal for Fiscal Year 1997, which includes:**

funding or funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further  
prior approval by this Council.
