WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance is in the process of purchasing this parcel from the United States Bureau of Land Management for the purpose of continual usage of this parcel as a cemetery for the Hia-Ced O'odham; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation will continue to allow use of this parcel as a cemetery by the Hia-Ced O'odham for their families; and

WHEREAS, the Hia-Ced O'odham Alliance is agreeable to selling the parcel to the Tohono O'odham Nation and conveying it to the United States in trust.
