Representative of Gu Vo District and Directing Election Board to
Issue Notice to District)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 96-275

WHEREAS, by the attached facsimile transmission to the Chairman of the Legislative Council received on July 1, 1996, Michael Flores submitted a letter dated June 26, 1996 resigning from his position as Legislative Council representative for the Gu Vo District; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(3) of Article XI of the Uniform Election Ordinance, Ord. No. 03-86 (the "Election Ordinance"), Mr. Flores' resignation was unconditional, was effective June 26, 1996 and does not require formal acceptance by the Legislative Council or any other governmental body of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Council representative position formerly occupied by Mr. Flores is deemed vacant as of June 26, 1996 under Section 1 of Article XI of the Election Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Council is informed by the Election Board that there is no alternate for this position; and

WHEREAS, under Article II of the Election Ordinance, the Election Board is empowered to implement the provisions of the Ordinance; and

WHEREAS, under Section 6(3) of Article XI of the Election Ordinance, it is the responsibility of the Gu Vo District Council to appoint a representative for the vacant position on the Legislative Council and an alternate for such position.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED THAT:

- 1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby acknowledges receipt of the unconditional resignation of Michael Flores from his position as Legislative Council representative of the Gu Vo District.**
- 2. The Legislative Council authorizes and directs the Election Board to issue an appropriate notice to the Gu Vo District Council to appoint a Legislative Council representative to assume the vacant position and to appoint an alternate for such representative.**


