(Supporting the Proposal to develop a Reservation Information
Management System (RIMS))

RESOLUTION NO. 96-276

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the RIMS proposal developed by the Intertribal Transportation Association (ITA); and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation manages a geographic area consisting of, Sells 2,773,357 acres, San Xavier 71,095 acres and Gila Bend with 10,409 acres with over 14,770 inhabitants; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation manages many complex issues such as illegal immigrants, drug smugglers, and impacts from NAFTA in addition to the usual social and economic development needs of the Nation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation needs a management information system that can provide modern planning capabilities to plan for and manage these issues; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources Committee of the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed the RIMS proposal developed by the Intertribal Transportation Association; and

Council requests the Federal Agencies listed in the proposal to
participate in the development of RIMS.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation requests the
Administration for Native Americans to assume the role of "Lead
Agency" in this endeavor.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 9TH
day of JULY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote
1,591.0 FOR; 80.0 AGAINST; 71.0 NOT VOTING; and 134.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant
to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (1) of the Constitution
of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
