4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation, through it's Planning and Operations  
5 Department did advise the Communities and Districts of the Tohono  
6 O'odham Nation of the availability of funds and types of eligible  
7 projects for the Department of Housing and Urban Development's  
8 Indian Community Development Block Grant Program (ICDBG); and

11 **WHEREAS,** the following communities and Districts did request ICDBG funding  
12 for FY 1996: Charco 27 Community, Hickiwan District, San Luis and  
13 Palo Verde Stands Communities, Gu Achi District, South Komelic,  
14 Little Tucson and Artesia Communities, Baboquivari District; and  
15 Cockleburr Community, Sif Oidak District; and

19 **WHEREAS,** the Department of Housing and Urban Development will not rate and  
20 rank an application if the request for funds exceeds the grant ceiling  
21 limit; and

23 **WHEREAS,** the Commerce, Housing and Budget and Finance Committees of the  
24 Tohono O'odham Nation Legislative Council have reviewed the  
25 prioritization of the projects requested of the Tohono O'odham




