

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(TOUA to Maintain and Operate Wastewater and Water Systems)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-291**

**WHEREAS, the Charco 27 Community, Little Tucson, Artesia and South Komelic Communities, Palo Verde Stands and San Luis Communities, Cockleburr Community have requested Wastewater and Water System maintenance; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Utility Authority (TOUA) has the technical expertise and resources required to provide and adequately maintain these systems; and**

**WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the HICKIWAN, BABOQUIVARI, GU ACHI and SIF OIDAK Districts and the Tohono O'odham Nation that operation and maintenance be provided by TOUA.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby grants that these systems be turned over to TOUA to provide operation and maintenance, once the projects are completed and operational.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that TOUA is hereby granted the necessary Rights-of-Way in order to allow maintenance and operation of the water and wastewater systems.**

7 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
8 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16  
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


