

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Individuals with Disabilities Education Act Grant No. 1450GTH54T61042 FY
1995/1996 BIA Grant Extension, October 01, 1995 - September 30, 1996)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-300

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the FY 1995 P.L.
93-638 grant with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the
nurturance of its young members by providing for their welfare
through various programs and services designed to meet their special
needs; and

WHEREAS, the Early Intervention for Infants and Toddlers Program has been
operated throughout the Tohono O'odham Nation and has served
many Tohono O'odham children by the Bureau of Indian Affairs,
Department of Education; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of funding for the Early Intervention
Program for Infants and Toddlers Program through the Bureau of
Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 102-119, the Individuals with
Disabilities Education Act as amended; and

WHEREAS, funds are to be used to assist the State of Arizona in child find,
screening, and other procedures for the early identification of Indian
children ages 3 - 5 and parent training; and

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**WHEREAS, such funds may also be used to provide early intervention services to
involve parents in the development and implementation of these
activities.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Chairman of the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the proposal for FY
95/96 Early Intervention for Infants and Toddlers Program in
accordance with the Disabilities Education Act as amended.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the grant will be from October
01, 1995 - September 30, 1996.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the
Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any
designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute
the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the
funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior
approval by the Council.**

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4 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
5 12TH day of JULY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
6 vote 1,397.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 479.0 [10] ABSENT,
7 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the
8 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
9 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
10 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
11 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




