

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL

(Tohono O'odham Head Start Supplemental Grant Funds for Program Improvement, Expansion Assuring Program Quality and Training and Technical Assistance)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-302

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Head Start Program to provide and serve educational and preschool learning experiences for children between ages of 3 - 5; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services, Administration for Children, Youth and Families has announced supplemental funds for (1) Program Improvement, (2) Expansion Assuring Program Quality and (3) Training and Technical Assistance; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared proposals for the supplemental funds to be submitted to the Department of Health and Human Services.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council does hereby approve the Head Start Supplemental Grants Proposals for (1) Program Improvement; (2) Expansion Assuring Program Quality; and (3) Training and Technical Assistance.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to

negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 12TH day of JULY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 947.0 FOR; 187.0 AGAINST; 263.0 NOT VOTING; and 479.0 [10] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1 (f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


