

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Amendment No. 1 to Construction Contract with Vi-ikam Doag
Industries and Appropriating \$19,500 in Supplemental Funding for Contract)**

RESOLUTION NO. 96-308

WHEREAS, by Resolutions 96-213 and 96-220, the Legislative Council authorized the Chairman of the Nation to execute a Construction Contract with Vi-ikam Doag Industries ("VDI") and appropriated the sum of \$30,100 to fund the work to be performed under the Contract; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Contract is to complete the Nation's share of the renovation work necessary to enable Bank of America Arizona to open a branch bank in office space at the Sells Shopping Center; and

WHEREAS, certain upgrades in the flooring, electrical system and other renovation items, as well as other unanticipated costs have occurred which were not a part of VDI's bid on this project: and

WHEREAS, the Commerce and Budget & Finance Committees recommend that Council appropriate the additional sum of \$19,500 to cover these costs and approve Amendment No. 1 to the Contract to incorporate the additional funding and items of work.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that:

- 1. The Legislative Council hereby approves the attached Amendment No. 1 to that certain Construction Contract between**

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the Tohono O'odham Nation and Vi-ikam Doag Industries, bearing a Commencement Date of May 20, 1996 to add the additional funding and work items.

2. The Legislative Council appropriates the sum of \$19,500 from the Building Repair Account (No. 01-3003-772) for fiscal year 1996 to fund the additional costs reflected in Amendment No. 1 to the Construction Contract.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 22ND. day of JULY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,094.0 FOR; 364.0 AGAINST; 231.0 NOT VOTING; and 187.0 [06] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d)(2)(3) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
