

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'odham Head Start Program)**

RESOLUTION NO. 96-311

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has recognized the importance of Head Start Education and stimulation; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Head Start Program to provide and serve educational and pre-school learning experiences for children between the ages of 3 - 5 years; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health & Human Services, Administration for Children, Youth and Families has provided funding for the operation of the Head Start Program; and

WHEREAS, the Administration for Children, Youth & Families will provide funds for the continued operation of the Head Start Program to eligible and qualifying applicants; and

WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared a proposal of FY '97 program operations to be submitted to the Department of Health & Human Services; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Council has reviewed and approved the Head Start grant.

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3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council

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5 that it does authorize and request the Department of Health &

6 Human Services for the provision of services titled: Head Start

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8 Program.

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10 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the duration of this grant will be from

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12 November 01, 1996 through October 31, 1997.

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14 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or

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16 operate a program from which grants are requested herewith which

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18 have not been negotiated and executed by the Department of Health

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20 & Services prior to the start of the funding year.

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22 **BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the

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24 Chairman, Vice-Chairman and Treasurer of the Tohono O'odham

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26 Nation are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute this grant and

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28 any amendments thereto for the duration of the grant, provided

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30 however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding

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32 levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by

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34 this Council.

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3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
4 29TH day of JULY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
5 vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [03] ABSENT, pursuant
6 to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution
7 of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on
8 January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
9 Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June
10 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


