**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Nation  
fully supports the efforts of the Tucson Area NIHB Local Planning  
Committee and will approve a financial assistance contribution in the  
amount of \$10,000 to be used for all activity expenses incurred  
throughout the conference.**

29TH. day of JULY, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
vote 1,016.5 FOR; 172.5 AGAINST; 687.0 NOT VOTING; and [05] ABSENT, pursuant  
to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(d), of the Constitution  
of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on  
January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian  
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June  
18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
