RESOLUTION NO. 96-330

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services/Family Assistance and Child Welfare Services has the primary responsibility to provide for the care, treatment and welfare of O'odham families found to be in the need of such care; and

WHEREAS, Title IV-B Subpart 1 and Subpart 2 of the Social Security Act provides funds for development of a Five Year Plan for demonstrating effective prevention approaches for handling increasing family problems under specified terms and conditions; and

WHEREAS, a proposal to continue the Five Year Plan has been submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'odham Department of Human Services/Child Welfare Services for the FY 1997 Family Preservation/Support Services Program, Title IV-B, Subpart 2.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the application of the Tohono O'odham Human Services to the Department of Health and Human Services/Administration for Children and Families to continue the development of the Five Year Plan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed grant has been approved by the Department of Health and Human Services/Administration for Children and Families.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 7TH day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,876.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and [02] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
