**WHEREAS, the Chairperson of the San Lucy District presented to the Council
the concerns and complaints by employees of the Tohono O'odham
Farms; and**

**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Farms Manager and the Farm Board were
present at a meeting held on June 19, 1996 to hear the concerns
addressed by the employees of the farms.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that due to the concerns addressed, the
Agriculture Committee is hereby directed to conduct an
investigation regarding the Tohono O'odham Farms.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Agriculture Committee conduct
an investigation regarding the Tohono O'odham Farms and that the
report be brought forth before the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council when completed.**


