**(To Table the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority's Plan of Operations Amendments until further review by the Nation's Districts and Entities and that it be addressed within 30 days)**

**LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 96-336**

**WHEREAS, during the August 7, 1996 General Session, included on the agenda was the proposed amendments to the Tohono O'odham Farming Authority's Plan of Operation; and**

**WHEREAS, the proposed amendments were not provided to the Nation's Districts and entities.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby directs that the proposed amendments to the Plan of Operations be tabled and brought forth to the Legislative Council within 30 days after input has been solicited by above entities and/or parties.**

**The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 7TH. day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,495.0 FOR; 239.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 142.0 (04) ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(1) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**


