NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative

Council does hereby acknowledge the resignation of Mary Jane

Juan-Moore as Legislative Council Representative for the Schuk

Toak District, effective August 5, 1996.

The foregoing Order was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the <u>7TH.</u> day of <u>AUGUST</u>, <u>1996</u> at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of <u>1,759.0</u> FOR; <u>-0-</u> AGAINST; <u>117.0</u> NOT VOTING; and <u>(05)</u> ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section <u>1(1)</u> of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
