

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Approving Budget Modification #2 for the Lead Program)**

**RESOLUTION NO. 96-353**

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4 **WHEREAS, in June of 1994, Resolution No. 94-158 of the Legislative Council**  
5 **approved the submission of a grant application to the EPA to fund**  
6 **a training, education, and information-gathering program aimed at**  
7 **determining whether there is a lead contamination problem on the**  
8 **Nation; and**

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11 **WHEREAS, delays have created the need for amendments to the assistance**  
12 **agreement to extend the grant from ending 7/14/95 to ending**  
13 **1/14/96, and then again to ending 9/30/96; and**

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16 **WHEREAS, the resulting amendments have created a deficit in the salary line**  
17 **item for FY96; and**

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19 **WHEREAS, the attached budget modification corrects the FY96 budget to**  
20 **provide enough salary for the program.**

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22 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative**  
23 **Council hereby approves the attached budget modification for the**  
24 **Lead Program.**  
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3 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the  
4 9TH day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a  
5 vote 1,642.5 FOR; 128.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [02] ABSENT,  
6 pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the  
7 Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
8 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
9 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16  
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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
