

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Application for 5 Year Plan for Women, Infant & Children)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-354

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4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation has provided preventive health care for
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6 women, infants and children during Fiscal Year 1996; and

7 **WHEREAS,** the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from the United
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9 States Department of Agriculture for programs designed to benefit
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11 women, infants and children; and

12 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Nation submits to the Inter-Tribal Council of
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14 Arizona an application for a proposal for a 5 year plan, to be
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16 amended each year dependent on allocation of funds; and

17 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'odham Women, Infants and Children program
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19 continues to provide services to eligible clients; and

20 **WHEREAS,** services provided to eligible clients have been beneficial and services
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22 continue to be necessary to help alleviate nutritional health risks and
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24 improve the health of individuals at risk.

25 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
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27 that it does hereby approve the application for a 5 year plan from
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the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona to be amended each year

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dependent upon allocation of funds to continue to operate and provide services to eligible women, infants and children.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this Memorandum of Agreement will commence on October 01, 1996 through September 30, 2001.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations/amendments are still being conducted and no executed agreement has been approved by the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the Chairman and any designated Official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the Memorandum of Agreement, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


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The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 9TH day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [04] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f) of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
