WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is desirous to continue to provide Child Care Services to its young tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Early Childhood Headstart Program has submitted for review and approval the proposed budget Modification #1 in the amount of \$431,859.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council fully supports the 1996 Child Care Development Block Grant Budget Modification #1 in the amount of \$431,859.00.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman, Vice-Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.


