WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Law
Enforcement and Detention Services/Anti-Drug Program under FY
1995/1996 P.L. 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

WHEREAS, such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the
Tohono O'odham Nation and its people; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has been notified of Border Patrol
initiative funds; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved
the FY 1996 Ranger Program proposal and budget.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau of Indian
Affairs to incorporate the Tohono O'odham Nation Ranger Program
into Contract #H50C142061060 Law Enforcement and Detention
Services/Anti-Drug Program under P.L. 93-638 as amended for the
provision of services titled: Tohono O'odham Nation Ranger
Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this renewal shall commence on
October 01, 1995 through September 30, 1996.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman
and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and
execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments
affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be
submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
21ST. day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a
vote 1,741.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 135.0 [06] ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16
of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
