

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Individuals with Disabilities Education Act Grant Number: 1450GTH54T61042
FY 1996/1997 Grant Extension, October 1, 1996 - September 30, 1997)

RESOLUTION NO. 96-372

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the
nurturance of its young members by providing for their welfare
through various programs and services designed to meet their special
needs; and

WHEREAS, the Early Intervention for Infants and Toddlers Program has been
operated throughout the Tohono O'odham Nation and has served
many Tohono O'odham children; and

WHEREAS, the Nation has been informed of additional funding for the Early
Intervention Program for Infants and Toddlers Program through the
Bureau of Indian Affairs pursuant to Public Law 102-119, the
Individuals with Disabilities Education Act as amended; and

WHEREAS, funds are to be used to assist the State of Arizona in child find,
screening and other procedures for early identification for the early
identification of Indian children ages 3 - 5 years old inclusive, and
for parent training; and such funds may also be used to provide
early intervention services; and to involve parents in the
development and implementation of these services.

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NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approve the proposal for FY 96/97 Early Intervention for Infants and Toddlers Program in accordance with the Individuals with Disabilities Education Act as amended.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the grant will be from October 01, 1996 through September 30, 1997.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials to wit: the Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding levels of this grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by the Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 22ND. day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [05] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
