**WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has consistently supported the
nurturance of its young members by providing for their welfare
through various programs and services designed to meet their special
needs; and**

**WHEREAS, the disabilities effort provided as part of the Tohono O'odham
Nation's Head Start Program is designed to meet the special needs
of children 3-5 years old; and**

**WHEREAS, in order to meet the needs of children with special needs 3-5 years
old, the Head Start - Disabilities budget has modified line items,
added line items and eliminated unnecessary line items without
altering the total budget amount.**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
Council that it does hereby approve the Head Start - Disabilities
modified budget.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the
22ND. day of AUGUST, 1996 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
a vote 1,771.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 105.0 [04] ABSENT,
pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Article VI, Section 1(f), of the
Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham**
